

Timber Trail Adventures – Walker Information

Kia Ora Timber Trail walkers.

The timber trail is an 85 km cycle trail cut through the middle of the Pureora Forest Park in the middle of the north island. Trail users tend to move from North to South, with the starting point Pureora village (near Benneydale); the middle in Piropiro (in the middle of nowhere)

and ending at Ongarue (which is 15 – 20 kms north of Taumaranui).



Timber Trail Adventures is an operator that provides services to the timber trail including shuttle transport, bike hire, accommodation and hospitality.

Lodge Accommodation

Our Lodge is situated at Piropiro which is in the middle of the Trail. The lodge is a 20 room purpose built lodge for cyclists and adventurers who are enjoying the trail. The lodge has facilities including a commercial

Food/ hospitality - Piropiro

The lodge is primarily set up to serve our lodge guests. As we are able we can serve 'walk-in' customers with pizza and refreshments. Based on availability we can serve visitors between 1 pm and 4.30pm Please note that we do not serve alcohol to guests who are driving or riding. We also have some basic shop items on sale such as drinks and snacks.



Bike Hire and Transport

We are finding that many walkers (Te Araroa Trail) are switching modes and riding the timber trail. Our team at Timber Trail Shuttles and Bike Hire are set-up to meet walkers are Pureora Village with hire bikes for walkers to ride the trail. We can deliver bikes, relocate baggage between Pureora, Piropiro and Ongarue and we have day packs we can lend to carry items on the ride.
